1. Rising tide job should be handled with the appropriate amount of tide above MLLW
2. The maximum draft limits in slip #3 are valid to 50 ft west of bulkhead. There are soundings indicating less than 31 ft within 50 ft of bulkhead at berth #14 and less than 36 ft in berth #13.
3. Vessel drawing less than 35 ft may go to the zero mark at berth #30 on any tide. Vessels of 35 - 37 ft may go to the zero mark on high water. Vessels drawing over 40 ft must berth 15 feet east of the zero mark.
